4. Arrival of the Chief Guest

The Vice-Chancellor, Registrar and the Controller of Examinations will receive the Chief Guest on his arrival.

II. WEARING STOLES

IV. ACADEMIC PROCESSION

The Chancellor, Pro-Chancellor, Chief Guest, Guest of Honour, Vice-Chancellor, Members of the Governing Body, Members of the Board of Management, Members of the Academic Council, Registrar, Controller of Examinations and Deans of the Schools shall proceed in procession to the Auditorium in which the Degrees are to be conferred.

The order of procession is as follows:

5. Members of the Board of Management (in rows of two)
6. Members of the Governing Body (in rows of two)
7. The Vice-Chancellor
8. Honorary Degree Awardee(s)
9. Guest of Honour
10. Chief Guest
11. The Pro-Chancellor
12. The Chancellor

When the Academic Procession enters the Auditorium, the candidates and the invitees shall rise and remain standing until all those on the dais have taken their seats.

The Chancellor shall say:

“I request Dr./Shri. ----- to accept and receive the Honorary Doctorate”

I request the Honorable Chief Guest to present the Honorary Doctorate to Dr./Shri. -----”

XII. CONFERMENT OF HONORARY DOCTORATE

The Chancellor shall say:

“By virtue of the authority vested in me as the Chancellor of Mohan Babu University, I admit Dr./Shri. ----- to the Honorary Doctorate of the University”

XIII. ACCEPTANCE SPEECH BY THE GUEST OF HONOUR

The Chancellor shall say:

I invite Dr./Shri. ----- to deliver the acceptance speech and his address”

The Guest of Honour will deliver the address.

XIV. INVITING THE CHIEF GUEST TO DELIVER THE CONVOCATION ADDRESS

The Chancellor shall say:

“I invite the Chief Guest Dr./Shri. ----- to deliver the Convocation Address”

The Chief Guest will deliver the Convocation address.

XV. PRESENTATION OF THE CANDIDATES FOR THE AWARD OF MEDALS, RANKS AND DEGREES

The Chancellor shall say:

“Let the Candidates be now presented”

XVIII.SIGNING THE REGISTER OF GRADUATES

The Registrar shall lay the records of the Degrees that have been conferred before the Chancellor, who shall sign the same.

XIX. DISSOLUTION OF CONVOCATION

At the conclusion of the proceedings, the Chancellor, Pro-Chancellor, Vice-Chancellor, Chief Guest, recipient(s) of Honorary Degree, Members of the Governing Body, Members of the Board of the Management, Members of the Academic Council, Registrar, Controller of Examinations and Deans of various Schools shall rise up and the Chancellor shall say:

“I dissolve this Convocation”
